

Community Water Company of Green Valley's DROUGHT PREPAREDNESS PLAN

Community Water Company's of Green Valley (Community Water) Drought Preparedness Plan includes four stages.

Stage 1: Normal

Stage 2: Severe Drought

Stage 3: Extreme Drought

Stage 4: Exceptional Drought.

Drought Stage approved by Community Water will be based on the drought level determined by Pima County, City of Tucson and WaterCASA members, unless determined otherwise by Community Water Company's board.

Community Water management's messages to its customers will be as follows:

STAGE 1: NORMAL

In Stage 1, Community Water management will provide slight to moderate education on water conservation. Community Water will educate its customers through billing inserts and newspaper ads on the value of water and methods to preserve this finite resource, and encourage customers to install low-water use landscaping and repair leaks in irrigation systems.

STAGE 2: SEVERE DROUGHT

In Stage 2, Community Water management will increase the level of education for its customers on water conservation. It will also ensure that sufficient financial resources are dedicated to inform its customers on the more severe stage and provide education through fliers and/or classes to inform customers on ways to save water.

STAGE 3: EXTREME DROUGHT

In Stage 3, Community Water management will request its Board to allocate funding that will be used specifically for the education of customers on water conservation. Funding will be used to inform customers of the drought situation and the need to benefit to save water voluntarily and recommend limiting water usage for necessary purposes.

STAGE 4: EXCEPTIONAL DROUGHT

In Stage 4, Community Water management will activate its Curtailment Plan, which was approved by the Arizona Corporation Commission in 2003.
